

Parracombe Art Exhibition 17th – 19th May 2024

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This is a fund-raising exhibition. All proceeds will be used to support Parracombe village projects.

1. Deadline for entries is Friday 10th May.
2. Handing-in days are Thursday 16th May 7.30pm-8.30pm and Friday 17th May 9am-10am at Parracombe Village Hall, EX31 4RJ.
3. There will be an entry fee of £5 for which up to four paintings may be submitted. Original works only.
4. With the exception of unframed canvases all paintings for hanging must be framed. Works must not exceed 30"/76cm on the longest side.
5. If you are entering works for hanging, you may also provide up to 10 unframed paintings/prints to be displayed in a browser for an additional fee of £5. In addition you may provide any number of greetings cards (no fee). Unframed paintings/prints for the browser must be wrapped. Greetings cards should be individually labelled/printed with the artists name and price of the card. You can supply your own display stand for cards if you wish.
6. All work must bear a label with the title of the work, name of the artist and the price (if it is for sale). Each entry that requires hanging must have hooks, strings or wire attached.
7. Parracombe Art Club reserve the right to have selected work in reserve for the duration of the exhibition and to alter the hang of the show at any point. Please be aware that we cannot guarantee that all reserved work will be part of the final hang.
8. Copyright remains with the artist. However, by submitting the work and agreeing to the terms and conditions, the artist agrees that their work can be used for the promotion of the exhibition in both printed and digital promotion.
9. The Exhibition will be manned throughout opening times and the venue securely locked when closed. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure the safety of individuals and their property and the smooth running of the event, it should be noted that individual artists are not covered for either damage or loss of their artwork, or Public Liability, and that they are responsible for taking out their own insurance should they wish to do so.
10. A commission of 20% will be deducted from the sale price of all works sold, including greetings cards.
11. Works sold during the exhibition may be removed by the purchaser, provided that the full sale price has been paid. However, we strongly recommend to purchasers that the work remains part of the exhibition until it closes.
12. All unsold work must be collected at the close of the exhibition between 4pm and 5.30pm on Sunday 19th May unless by prior arrangement.
13. If a third party is collecting work on your behalf, they must bring the artist form/receipt or a letter saying that they have permission to collect. Work will not be released without this authority. Please bring ID with you when you are collecting your work.
14. Artists whose work has sold will be contacted after the exhibition and must supply the required documentation in order for payment to be made. Payment will be made by BACS.
